

# OKLAHOMA CPA PIPELINE

## MEMBER FEEDBACK RESULTS

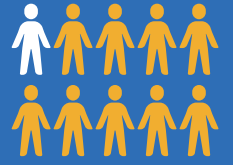
To assess current challenges of the CPA pipeline impacting Oklahoma, the OSCPAs surveyed current members, gathering feedback about their experience and thoughts around licensure requirements.

**5,065**

current members were invited to participate



**89.2%**



of respondents that are currently CPAs considered **career opportunities** as one of the most important factors when choosing to become a CPA



**50%**

of student members value **work-life balance and salary** as the most important factors when choosing to pursue their CPA



For comparison, 42% of students valued career opportunities as a reason for pursuing their CPA.

**When asked about job preparedness,**

**91%**

of respondents who are current CPAs felt somewhat or very prepared for their career, regardless of education requirements at time of achievement.



**48.6%**

of respondents support other alternatives for achieving CPA designation, and another 19.2% are unsure or have no opinion.



Of those who support alternative paths, 84% believe work experience should be considered and 60% support additional business or accounting coursework.
