


OKLAHONA CPA PIPELINE

MEMBER FEEDBACK RESULTS

To assess current challenges of the CPA pipeline impacting Oklahoma, the OSCPA surveyed current members, gathering feedback about their experience and thoughts around licensure requirements.





of student members value work-life balance and salary as the most important factors when choosing to pursue their CPA



For comparison, 42% of students valued career opportunities

as a reason for pursuing their CPA.



When asked about job preparedness,



of respondents who are current CPAs felt somewhat or very prepared for their career, regardless of education requirements at time of achievement.



of respondents support other alternatives for achieving CPA designation, and another 19.2% are unsure or have no opinion.



Of those who support alternative paths, 84% believe work experience should be considered and 60% support additional business or accounting coursework.



of respondents consider professional mobility somewhat or very important.
